

Privacy statement pursuant to Legislative Decree no. 196/2003

Dear Customer

We wish to inform you, pursuant to Article 13 of the aforementioned Legislative Decree, containing provisions on the personal data protection of individuals and other entities, that any data provided by you or otherwise obtained in the context of our activities may be processed in accordance with the aforementioned provisions and subject to the confidentiality and professional secrecy obligations characterising our activity.

1. The data will be processed the following purposes:

1.1 Purposes instrumental to our Company's activities:

To obtain information preparatory to the signature of the contract and the planning of activities.

To implement the service and any contractually agreed operations and activities.

For requirements associated with operational activities and the internal management of accounts, payments and taxation, administrative and legal obligations.

To evaluate the progress of the service agreed and the course of the contractual relationship, also with reference to the proposal to extend the Service to any additional contract activities that may potentially be activated after the signature of the contract proposal.

For the fulfilment of any obligations provided for by legislative and regulatory provisions and EU rules, or by provisions handed down by the legally competent authorities.

The provision of personal data for such purposes is mandatory and the refusal to provide such data will make it impossible to establish contractual relations.

The processing of such data does not require the data subject's consent.

1.2 Secondary purposes of our Company's activities:

The personal data processing may be carried out:

In order to discover levels of Customer satisfaction with the quality of services rendered.

In order to carry out economic activities, in compliance with applicable rules, for purposes of commercial information provision, transmission of advertising material, direct sale of goods or services (ours or those of our partners), or for purposes of implementing market research or interactive commercial communications by email, post or telephone.

The provision of personal data for such purposes is not obligatory.

The processing of such data requires the data subject's consent.

2. Data collection methods

The data are collected from the data subject or from third parties, directly or by telephone or by electronic or paper means.

In relation to the purposes indicated, the data processing shall occur using manual, computer and electronic methods with logics that are strictly related to those purposes and, in any case, in a manner that ensures the safety, security and confidentiality of said data.

3. Context of communication and dissemination

3.1 Your personal data will not be disseminated.

3.2 Such data may be communicated or disclosed outside our organisation in the following circumstances:

to ensure compliance, as necessary, with legislative or regulatory obligations or EU rules, or with the provisions handed down by legally competent authorities.

To facilitate the implementation of our economic activities, which embrace companies, private or public entities (for example: after-sales services companies, banks, insurance companies), independent professionals, whose activities are associated with or instrumental to or which support the activities of our Company or those relating to the services referred to you.

The provision of personal data for such purposes is mandatory and any refusal to so provide will make collaboration impossible. The processing of such data does not require the data subject's consent.

3.3 Your data may also be communicated to third party companies for purposes of commercial information provision, transmission of advertising material, direct sale of goods or services or in order to carry out market research or interactive commercial communications by email, post or telephone.

The provision of personal data for such purposes is not obligatory.

The processing of such data requires the data subject's consent.

4. Right of access to personal data and other rights.

1. The data subject is entitled to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him exist, regardless of their being already recorded, and communication of such data in intelligible form.

2. The data subject is entitled to obtain information about:

a) the origin of the personal data;

b) the purposes and methods of the data-processing;

c) the logic applied in the event that the processing occurs with the help of electronic means;

d) the identification particulars of the Data Controller, of the Data Supervisors and of the designated representative pursuant to Article 5, subsection 2;

e) the entities or categories of entity to whom/which the personal data may be communicated and who/which may come to know said data in their capacity as designated representative(s) in the State's territory, Data Supervisors(s) or Data Processing Operator(s).

3. The data subject is entitled to:

a) the updating, rectification or, if appropriate, the supplementation of the data;

b) the erasure, anonymisation or blocking of data that have been processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which they have been collected or subsequently processed;

c) the certification that the operations as per letters a) and b) have been notified, also as regards their contents, to the entities to whom/which the data were communicated or disseminated, unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort compared with the importance of the right to be protected.

4. The data subject may object, in whole or in part:

a) for legitimate reasons, to the processing of personal data concerning him, even if they are relevant to the purpose of the data collection;

b) to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, where done for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct selling, or for market or commercial communication purposes.
